Dear Everyone,

At Easter we celebrate the great events of Christ's death and resurrection which are at the heart of our faith with services in both churches and online (see website for full details). Apart from 8am at St Michael's there are plenty of spaces: people seem to have thought they would leave them for others. So if you'd like to attend St Andrew's on **Good Friday** or **Easter Sunday** you are welcome (leave a message at the parish office so we know numbers). If you would be happy to read a Bible reading at one of the services please let me know. Of course everyone is welcome to the Easter stations at St Michael's and Easter garden trail in the community. I will share Communion at the Vicarage in the Zoom Easter Sunday service, so please have bread and wine (or similar) ready at home to join at the same time.

It is just a year since I sent the first Newsletter to the church community, informing you of the closure of the church buildings, giving information about the first tentative on-line services, and asking you to pray for those working on the front-line of what was then a largely unknown and unpredictable illness. Much has changed since then, and for most of us the fear of a year ago has given way to cautious optimism (though for many of our brothers and sisters around the world the situation remains grave). This will be the **final newsletter** as after Easter we revert to a weekly leaflet. My **retirement** is getting closer. I finish at the end of April, and we will move to our new home in Grantham in mid-May. So final services will be on Zoom at 9.30am on Sunday 25 April, followed by Evensong at St Andrew's at 6.00pm. There will be opportunity in the morning service for anyone to speak about how your faith has grown over the last 25 years or so, and to give thanks not for <u>me</u> but for what God has been doing among us. So think and pray about whether you would like to share something.

Live services continue in April, with Communion at 8am on Sunday 11th and 11am on 18th, then Evensong at 6pm on 25th, all in St Andrew's. No booking needed for these. From then on Zoom services continue until at least June 21. There will be Communion on the first Sunday of each month and All-Age Worship on third Sundays, both in St Andrew's at 11.00am. Booking will be necessary for All-Age Worship.

The **Bike Project** collects and fixes up bikes to donate to refugees to get around safely and cheaply. Most asylum seekers cannot work and live on £5.75 per day. If you have a surplus bike in <u>any</u> condition please drop it off between 10am and 2pm on Saturday 8 May at Croft House, Aqueduct Lane, Alvechurch, B48 7BP (first on the right from Bittell Road end).
