

Staying safe on your Light Trail

**Here are a few guidelines to keep you safe
as you walk around your Light Trail**

- This activity is for your household group of no more than 6.*
If there are people at your light stop already, maintain the correct social distance and wait for them to move on.
- Regrettably the organisers** can't accept responsibility for unforeseen incidents, so all children must be accompanied at all times for the whole event by an adult who will take sole responsibility for their care and safety.
- Be careful as you cross roads
- Be seen: think about warm, reflective or light coloured clothing
- Plan your route before you leave the house: perhaps use Google maps
- Carry a torch so you can see what's around you and where to walk safely.
- Use hand sanitiser in case you touch things
- Be respectful as you walk around the neighbourhood
- Do not enter gardens/go up to residences – everything is visible from the road
