Food Bank

The Pantry@ St Stephen's We continue to help an ever-increasing number of pantry client families who are so grateful for the food that we are able to supply through the generosity of the congregations of St Stephen's, St Andrew's and St Michael's and through the waste food donations from local supermarkets collected by our amazing volunteers. Thank you to all who responded to last week's emergency text for food as we had run out of nearly everything. If you can help this week we would be so grateful. Special requests are for **squash, pasta sauces, flavoured instant noodles, household cleaning products, toiletries, tinned vegetables and meat meals (such as minced beef, chicken in sauce, chilli, ravioli, meatballs, etc)**, as well as cereals, pasta shapes (rather than spaghetti), milk, tuna baked beans, instant mash, soup, toilet rolls, tea, coffee and sugar. Thank you so much for all your ongoing support, it is really appreciated.

Climate Crisis Action

Think about packaging: There are zero-waste shops where you buy unpackaged food. But you can also go to the supermarket and make better choices by buying unpackaged fruit and vegetables, or opting for cans and cardboard that are widely recycled instead of plastic. So there are better choices that you can make in regular shops.
