

We are now helping around 16 pantry client families and they are really grateful for the food that we are able to supply through the amazing generosity of the congregations of St Stephen's, St Andrew's and St Michael's and through the waste food donations from local supermarkets collected by our volunteers.

A Green back to school wardrobe. The used clothing market has exploded, offering your child, regardless of age, an abundance of pre-owned clothing options, from online thrift stores and social media platforms to high-end resale sites.

While earth-friendly, the second-hand clothing route to school clothing is also budget-friendly with deals to be had for fashionable, pre-loved items. Another way to stay green is to dispose of the clothing your child has outgrown in an environmentally responsible way.
