

#### Food Bank

The Pantry@ St Stephen's Thank you to the wonderful congregations of St Stephen's, St Andrew's and St Michael's, our volunteers and our local supermarket food waste partners. Our many family clients are really grateful for the help that the Pantry provides. If you can help this week please do. Special requests are for toilet rolls, instant mash, and toiletries (Eg deodorant, shower gel) and household cleaning products (Eg surface spray, washing liquid, bin bags) as well as meat meals (such as minced beef, ravioli, chicken in sauce, chilli, meatballs etc), squash, cereals, toilet rolls, tuna, milk, pasta shapes and sauce, flavoured noodles, microwave rice, tinned potatoes and vegetables, baked beans, soup, tea, coffee and sugar. Thank you so much for your donations, they make such a difference.

### **Climate Crisis Action**

Help birds in hot weather. Keeping your bird bath topped up with fresh water in warmer weather can be a life saver for our feathered friends. Get your garden birds through a heatwave when natural supplies, like worms, become scarce, by putting out supplementary food- black sunflower seeds, pinhead oatmeal. Soaked sultanas, raisins and currants, mealworms, waxworms and good seed mixture.
