Thank you for all the stamps left in the shoe box in St Andrews in the last month. The stamps are sold on by weight not by number or value. Therefore leaving a 1cm margin around the stamp is ideal. Even better if the stamp is attached to a piece of post card. The margin can be increased to maintain the integrity of a postmark. A light, neat and perfectly centred 'Circular Date Stamp' that leaves the stamp design visible adds aesthetic and therefore collector value.
